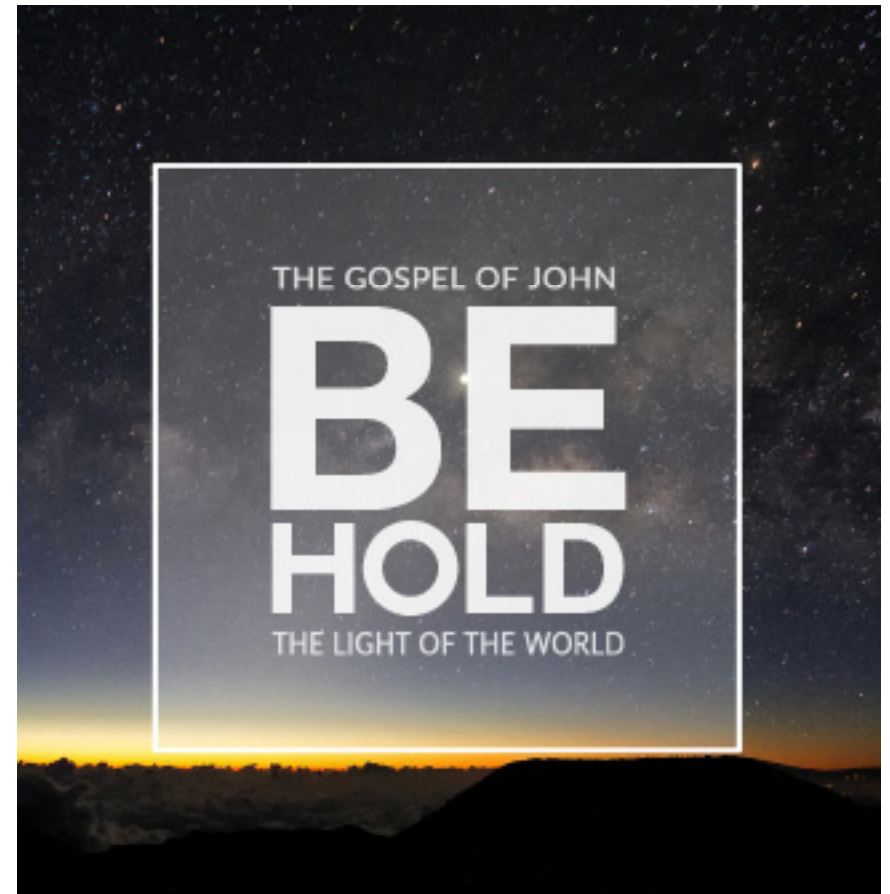


Discussion Questions for Personal Growth

4. If someone were to ask you who you are, what would you say?
5. What is the significance of the term "Lamb of God?" See verses 29 and 35.
6. After reading how John the Baptist speaks about Jesus in verse 27, how should you speak of Jesus to others?
7. Read verse 34 and Romans 6: 3-4. What is the purpose of baptism? What is baptism of the spirit?
8. How can you bear witness to non-Christians about who Jesus is?
