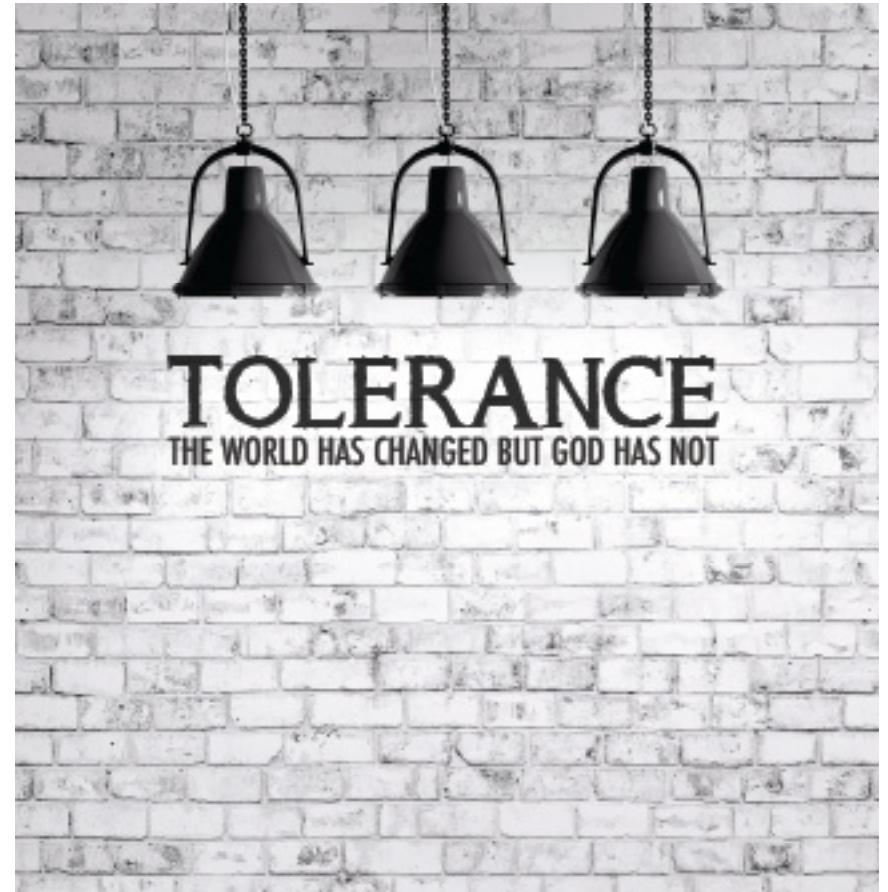


Discussion Questions for Personal Growth

6. What should be the focus of your non-Christian friendships? Explain why.
7. How should Christians live in the world among non-Christians?
8. Read 1 Corinthians 5:12-13. Why is it loving to confront a brother or sister in Christ about their sin issues?
9. What is the difference between "habitual sin" and "non-habitual sin"?
10. Read 1 Corinthians 5:6-7. Why does keeping purity in the church matter?
11. Why does God call Christians to take action when a professed Christian will not repent?
