

Discussion Questions for Personal Growth

1. Why is it important that Jesus said on resurrection day "Go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee, there they will see me?" (Matthew 26:31-33, Matthew 28:7, Matthew 28:10, 16-17)
2. Were these final words and meeting place random or by chance?
3. Is there anything unclear about what Jesus said in Matthew 28? What were the marching orders?
4. What is a nation?
5. What is significant about the command tense in Mark 16:15 (which is also likely from the Galilee location)?
6. Read Luke 24:45-47 (Which is from a room in Jerusalem). Jesus has all the canon to pick from and highlights two points only (using the same word for nation as in Matthew). What does this mean?
7. In Acts 1:6-8 we have a third location, the Mount of Olives, but the message is the same. What is it?
8. How important are someone's last words? Do you think this message is only for a few or for everyone?
9. Does Jerusalem mean Bakersfield or Jerusalem? Does serving in your hometown count as making disciples of all nations?
10. Do you have someone in your life that challenges you to live fully for God? Why or why not?
11. In light of this being our Savior's last command how does this 'crimp or impact' my life, plans, future? DOES this affect the way I live my life?
