Read John 12.

1. Read 12:8. What is Jesus' point about feeding the poor?
2. Read 12:20-26. What does it mean to die to yourself? (read Luke 9:23-26, Galatians 2:20) How do you die to yourself?
3. How do you know if you are dying to self and living for Jesus?
4. How do you live a life of purpose for God's glory?
5. Read 12:35-36 and 46. Why is walking in darkness so terrible?
6. What is the benefit of (spiritually) walking in the light? What does it mean to be a son of the light?
7. Read 12:47-48. If Jesus did not come to judge, does that mean he will not judge in the future? What does Jesus judge? (read John 5:22-27, 2 Corinthians 5:10)
8. Read 12:24-26. What does it mean to hate your life in this world? Why are Jesus' words so strong?
9. What is the balance between enjoying God's creation and hating the life of the world?
10. How does dying to the life of the world bear much fruit?
11. What does it mean to follow Jesus? Is this a casual following, or an "all in" following?
