6. If the Holy Spirit's role is to help us and teach us, what is our role?
7. Read 14:30-31. How did Jesus obey God and what does this show about Jesus?
8. Read 14:1, 27-28. Why should our hearts not be troubled?
9. Read 14:27. What is the peace that Jesus gives that the world does not give?
10. Read 14:23. God makes his home in the life of a believer; do you ever bring anything into his house that is sinful? If so what and why?
11. Read 14:16-17. Do you find any comfort in knowing God has given us a helper/advocate to dwell in us? If so how? How do you know when your comfort is from the Holy Spirit rather than from the world?
12. Based on what you have read, what are some things you need to change or areas you need to grow in?
