Read John 18.

1. Have you ever had a belief that you thought was in the Bible but actually wasn't?
2. Can you locate your beliefs in the Bible now? Should you be concerned if you cannot?
3. What are some Christian doctrines that people add to the Bible that are not actually in the Bible and why?
4. What are some doctrines that people ignore in the Bible, and why?
5. Did Jesus shy away from the truth when asked about His deity? What can we learn from His responses when He was asked who He is and what He believes?
6. Do you agree with C.S. Lewis that all people must decide whether Jesus is liar, lunatic, or Lord? Why or why not?
7. How are legalistic people often very hypocritical?
8. How can sin in our lives twist the truths of scripture?
9. What does it mean "to bear witness to the truth?" What does it mean to be "of the truth?" See verse 37.
10. How can you make sure that the sin in your heart is not twisting the truth of scripture?
