

Discussion Questions for Personal Growth

Read Revelation 21:1-8.

1. Read 21:5-6. What is the significance that Jesus is seated on heaven's throne?
2. What promise did Jesus make before he left the disciples? (read Matthew 28:16-20)
3. What makes heaven so great? Why do people say that they would rather stay on earth than go to heaven?
4. Read 21:6. What does it mean that Jesus will give the water of life without payment?
5. What is the significance that Jesus gives living water without payment? Where else did John mention living water in the gospel of John? What was the significance of it?
6. What does it mean to be "one who conquers" in verse 7?
7. What does it mean if someone knows the truth of the gospel but does not share it?
8. Read 21:8. Who are the people that do not go to heaven and why?
9. What does verse 8 tell us about what hell is going to be like? Read Revelation 20:10. Does it indicate that hell is eternal or temporary? (read also Revelation 14:9-11, 19:3)
10. Knowing what heaven is like and what hell is like, how should that impact our desire to share what we believe?
11. Why is it so important that we believe that Jesus is the Son of God and the payment for our sins?
12. How should we live in light of the fact that heaven is the eternal home for believers in Jesus Christ?
