Thank you for considering taking part in a summer mission team! You will be blessed as you follow the Lord's leading for this adventure. This page contains information about each of the three teams we are sending out this year. Please review it all, complete the attached application, and return it to the church office, along with the required deposit and documentation, no later than March 3, 2019. Late applications will be considered only if space allows. If you have questions about this process, contact our Missions Director, Rille Pinault, at 833-2800 or rille@laurelglen.org.

Goal: To make disciples of all nations by joining the work of in-country directors to serve the ministries; to encourage and serve the local church leadership and community; to mentor and disciple children and teenagers; etc. Each team has more specific goals, which you will learn about at the informational meeting on January 28.

Training dates: Each team has several meetings for planning, training, team-building, and preparing. Most meetings are mandatory. Dates are listed on the back of this page.

Physical condition required: You need to be able to handle your own luggage and work long days, possibly without a good night's sleep. The climates are different with much higher humidity. Flexibility in all areas of ministry is a priority.

Responsibility: Timely preparation of personal and team assignments and an individual prayer commitment are required. You must find a minimum of 10 prayer partners who will support you in prayer during the trip. You will be a member of a sub-team, which may have additional meetings. Flexibility and a submitted spirit during preparation and while on the trip are critical.

Other requirements: You must be at least 16 years old with parental permission and strong adult and pastoral recommendations in order to go. You must have a current US passport with at least six months left on it (12 months for India) at the time of departure. If you do not have a passport, please apply now. Sharing your testimony publicly is required. Everyone who fits these requirements is encouraged to apply!

What you will receive: A worldwide perspective that will CHANGE YOUR LIFE! The blessing of God as you see His power work through you. Lifelong memories of serving together on this team. Your own family and friends seeing you take the Great Commission seriously as a participant.

Financial Support: Fundraising for your trip is accomplished by writing a personal letter explaining the project and requesting prayer and financial support. This letter is sent to a required number of people that is based on the total amount you need to raise. Your team leader will guide you in this. If you can fully fund your own trip, you must still send out a minimum of 30 letters requesting prayer support, and \$2000 will be due in April in order to pay for plane tickets. If you send out fewer than the required number of letters, you must be prepared to self-fund the difference between what you raise and the total needed. The cost of a passport and any vaccinations required are at your expense. We realize that raising support can seem like a challenge for some and we're here to help you succeed as we rely on the Lord together. With Him all things are possible!
