Ministry Description - Summer 2018

Summary

Remedy Ministry interns are positioned and empowered to develop fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ aiding in the mission of Laurelglen Bible Church. Summer Interns can expect to serve throughout Remedy ministries in differing degrees and scope with the majority of assignments coming through their assigned ministry. These ministries include Junior High and High School. Actual assignments will vary based upon each intern's desires, their gifting, as well as LBC needs. Intern selection is based upon ministry potential and ministry intentions as a career. LBC intends to provide intern's ministry experience, education, training, discipleship, and spiritual disciplines within the Biblical scope of shepherd leadership described in Matt 20:20-28.

This internship program is a tandem ministry of both LBC and the PDC (Pacific District Conference of Mennonite Brethren Churches). Interns are responsible to complete all PDC requirements as detailed in PDC publications as well as all LBC criteria contained here and in the summer 2018 Intern Info Sheet.

Summer Interns will be directly supervised by LBC staff as detailed in this document.

Qualifications

1. Personal

- a. Christian of good reputation / "Above reproach" as defined by 1 Timothy 3, Titus 1
- b. Appropriate spiritual gifts and motivations
- c. Relates well to people
- d. Committed to serve the people of God in love
- e. Full-time ministry intentions
- f. Demonstrated dependence upon God through prayer, humility, unity and power of His word

2. Ministry Skills

- a. Ability to follow through on responsibilities and duties / strong work ethic
- b. Basic computer skills
- c. Positive influencer
- d. Grasp of Biblical doctrine and spiritually mature
- e. Excellent communication skills / able to teach God's Word and related spiritual training

Duration

Twelve weeks in the summer 2018. Actual start and ending dates will be determined by LBC need, availability, and school schedules. LBC is an at will employer.

Drug Testing

Laurelglen Bible Church requires that you have a pre-employment drug test, and/or update/periodic drug tests. LBC will schedule the pre-employment test once you have been identified as a primary candidate for the position. You will not be able to start employment until this requirement has been met.

Start time/End times

- Request employment start and end times through written notification to supervisor Joel LePere who will approve based upon need and school requirements

Intern's basic responsibilities & components

- Get spiritually involved in student's lives trusting God for spiritual growth and maturity
- Attend assigned events, programs, meetings, and camps
- Offer one Bible Study event weekly - a small group study based on an assigned book (*gain book approval from the ministry supervisor*)
- All interns will serve in the following: *Note: approach the Ministry Supervisor when additional intern support is required*

General Schedule

- Ministry hours - 40 hr ministry week:
Establish your own schedule based upon your specific responsibilities and duties
Required times:

Tuesday	10:00AM – 12:00PM - All staff prayer meeting
Sunday	Attendance generally required @ one service weekly
- Start every ministry day with 45 min personal SOAP devotional/journal time
 - Scripture
 - Observation
 - Application
 - Prayer
- Details:
 - Two days off per week recommended
 - Time cards required (*see time card schedule for submission requirements*)
 - Volunteer time policy – up to 10 hours per week, interns designate where and when
 - No vacation time

Training program

- Internship training – Leadership/Spiritual training from ministry leaders
- Assigned reading/discussion: (*provided*) read at intern's discretion

Misc

- Expenditure procedures: All ministries related expenses must be “signed for” by the ministry department leader each expenditure affects. Receipts are required for reimbursement
- Keys: obtain from Facilities Supervisor and sign for policy acknowledgement
