

Discussion Questions for Personal Growth

Read John 12:44-13:20

1. Read John 12:47-50. How does judgment necessitate a need to be saved? If Jesus came to save does that mean that there will not be judgment?
2. Read John 13:1. Who does Jesus call as his "own"?
3. Read John 13:2 and 27. Can Satan enter the body of a believer? Read Matthew 12:43-45, 1 John 5:18, 1 John 4:4. Was Judas saved even though he followed Jesus as one of the original 12 disciples?
4. Read John 13:8-11. What does Jesus mean by saying "you are clean?"
5. If Jesus already cleansed believers, why do they need Jesus to "wash their feet"?
6. What is the difference between justification and sanctification? (read Romans 5:9 and Hebrews 10:14)
7. Read John 13:8. Why is Jesus the only one who can wash us? Why are we unable to wash our own feet?
8. Read 13:16. What has Jesus communicated by stating, "a servant is not greater than his master"?
9. Is there anything Jesus has done that you are unwilling to do? If so what or why not?
10. Has Jesus done something in your life that you did not understand until later? If so what and why do you think you did not understand initially?
