

Discussion Questions for Personal Growth

Read John 13:21-38

1. Read 13:21. What is your reaction to the fact that it says "Jesus was troubled in spirit"?
2. Read Hebrews 4:15-16. Do you tend to see Jesus as too perfect and glorious to approach? How can the truth of Hebrews 4:15-16 impact our looking to Christ in times of trouble?
3. Read 13:22-29. Why do you think the disciples were clueless about who was going to betray Jesus?
4. Read 13:27. What stands out to you about Satan entering Judas?
5. Read 1 Peter 5:8-9. As believers in Christ, Satan and his demons cannot possess us. According to scripture, what can they do to us? (See 2 Corinthians 11:3, etc.) According to 1 Peter 5:8-9 and other scriptures, what should our response be to Satan and his demons?
6. Read 13:31-32. What does it mean to glorify God? How did Jesus glorify God?
7. How can we glorify God through our trials?
8. Read 13:34-35. In what way is this NOT new and in what way is it new? (Read Leviticus 19:18, 34.)
9. In John 13 and in other scriptures, in what ways did Jesus show love to his 12 apostles as well as to us?
10. How can we have Christ-like love toward people who hurt us and people who let us down?
11. As a group spend time praying about any trials you're facing or people who currently are hurting you. Ask God for the grace and strength to love each other like Jesus has loved us.
