1. What troubles your heart the most currently and why?
2. How do you currently try to solve being troubled in your heart? How well does it work?
3. Does knowing Jesus has prepared a place for you comfort you? (if you're honest most likely it doesn't) Why should Jesus' words comfort you?
4. Why do we often not feel comforted by Jesus' words in John 14:1-6?
5. What needs to shift in your values and thinking for Jesus' words to comfort you?
6. What is the difference between worry and sorrow?
7. How does worry lead to not trusting Jesus and how can sorrow lead us to the comforts of Jesus?
8. What are the works that Jesus does that we are to do as well?
9. If we do not do the works of Jesus, what does that say about our faith?
10. What is the correlation between believing and doing the works of Jesus?
11. What does it mean to ask in the name of Jesus? Would you ask for a boat in the name of Jesus? If not, then what kind of prayer request should be asked in the name of Jesus?
12. Read verse 12-14. What are the stipulations to Jesus answering what we ask of him?
13. What is important to keep in mind before we pray and make requests to Jesus?
